OMB Uniform Guidance: Impact on the Grant Community

Summary: Grants management reform is here, and you need to begin now to adjust your procedures to shift their focus from “process” to “performance.” On Dec. 26, 2013, Office of Management Budget issued a new set of regulations covering federal grants. The document has been dubbed “the Super-Circular” because it revised virtually all of the general grant regulations: the administrative rules, the cost principles, and the single audit requirements. These new rules went into effect in December 2014.
